## COMPOSER BIOGRAPHY

Liam Ritz (b.1996) is a Canadian composer based in Toronto, Ontario.

As a composer, Ritz has collaborated with musicians and ensembles including the Hamilton Philharmonic Orchestra, Toronto Symphony Orchestra, Winniped Symphony Orchestra, National Youth Orchestra of Canada, Gemma New, Etsuko Kimura, Cameron Crozman, and more His works have been performed across Canada, as well as being programmed in the United States, Italy, Finland, Argentina, and Japan.

Recognized for his work, he has received multiple SOCAN Foundation Young

Composers Awards, a City of Hamilton Arts Award, was selected for the inaugural Hamilton Philharmonic Orchestra's Composer Fellowship Program (2018/2019), as well as the 2022/23 Winnipeg New Music Festival: Composers Institute and the 2024 Bowdoin International Music Festival: Composition Program.

A graduate of the University of Toronto, Ritz's work has been supported by organizations such as the Toronto Arts Council, Ontario Arts Council, Canada Council for the Arts, the RBC Emerging Artists Project, and the SOCAN Foundation.
